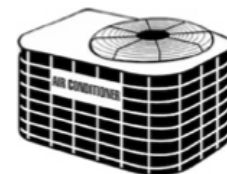

Most of us want to do more to fight crime, but are not sure HOW to do it. We don't have a lot of extra time to spend on it, either.

Crime fighting has been made simple and fast by the Memphis Police Department with the CYBERWATCH website. By following this link -- <https://kiosk.memphispolice.org/cyberwatch> -- you can find out how to help the police more effectively do their police work.

After you take a look at this link, you'll feel more comfortable about calling 545-COPS (545-2677) regarding things that might look suspicious; or a strange car parked on the street, something that looks out of place, or maybe a person who seems to be loitering in the area for no good reason.

Checking CYBERWATCH, and telling your neighbors about it, will help you be informed – and help all of us fight crime.

Our goal was to raise \$350 towards neighborhood events and committees. You showed your support overwhelming and we netted more than twice that amount! Further, 24 memberships were gained at the event which puts us on our way to the goal of 150 members.

I guess it goes without saying that we will definitely want to repeat this fundraiser/membership drive next year!

**Pet Spay and Neuter Services**

Mid-South Spay & Neuter Services (formerly the APA Spay & Neuter Clinic) is located in Normal Station at 854 Goodman. Our goal is to "fix" pet homelessness by offering affordable, high-quality spay & neuter services to the Memphis area.

Our surgery days are Tuesday through Friday. Dogs cost \$50-\$70, cats cost \$35-\$40, and feral cats cost \$25. We also offer vaccinations, heartworm and FIV/FELV testing, deworming, and microchipping at the time of surgery. More information can be found at [www.spaymemphis.com](http://www.spaymemphis.com).
